The SES PTA is an all-volunteer group of Sopris students' parents. Most volunteers work full-time jobs. Coordinating PTA programs and goals, and recruiting volunteers, can be a challenge.

Every year, all Sopris parents are automatically enrolled on the SES PTA Parent list serv. The SES PTA Parent list-serv sends out announcements about coming events, volunteer opportunities, and updates on SES PTA partner programs. (We don't sell or share your info!) Those wanting to get more involved are encouraged to join the SES PTA Member text-serv app. The text-serv app is used by PTA leaders and volunteers to coordinate the details of individual PTA events, assign specific volunteer duties, and discuss PTA governance topics. Currently the text-serv uses an app called "Remind" that is available for free download on the Apple App Store and the Google Play Store. Download the app and search for "SES PTA" to join the text serv.

In person PTA meetings are held once a month during the school year, on the second Tuesday of each month, in the Sopris Library. SES PTA volunteers and members of the Sopris Administration meet to discuss upcoming events, long term planning, cooperation with the school, and governance issues. ALL are invited - just show up.
